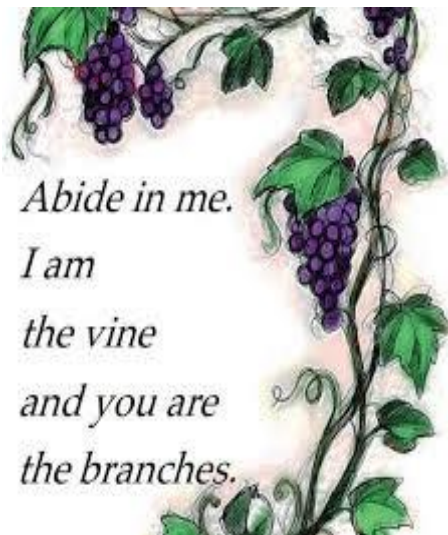




## The fifth Sunday of Easter.
