Anniversary Masses: Anniversary Masses which have been booked before the Covid-19 virus will take place on the day they were originally booked, unless the family wish to reschedule for another day. Priority is given to Months Mind Masses and to First Anniversary Masses. First Anniversary Masses should always be booked around the time of the Months Mind.
