Masses: All Masses in the Parish can be seen on Facebook. Type "Kilronan Parish" into your Facebook page for the link. Also Masses are broadcast live on local Radio in each of Church areas.

Mass Times Viqil Mass, Ballyfarnon Saturday 7p.m. Sunday; Arigna 10a.m and Keadue 11.30a.m. Weekday Masses @ 10a.m.; Monday, Keadue; Tuesday & Wednesday, Arigna. Thursday & Friday, Ballyfarnon.

Volunteers are required in Keadue to help guide people to their seats before the beginning of Mass and also to where and when they can join the queue to receive Holy Communion.

Members of the same households should sit in the same seat.

All volunteers are requested to attend a meeting in Keadue church on Wednesday next 1st July at 8.30p.m.

All three churches will reopen for Weekday Masses beginning Monday 29th.

Only Keadue Church will re-open for Mass on Sunday next 5th July at 11.30p.m.

Entry to Keadue church will be only via the entrance near the steps. Steward will be on hand to assist people to find a seat. People living in the same household should sit together in the same seat.

At the end of Mass please leave the Church through the double doors at the back of the Church, observing safe distancing.

If there is no room in the Church or if people prefer thy can remain in their cars and tune into the Parish Radio. Arrangements will be put in place for the distribution of Holy Communion to those in the church Car Park. People are reminded to keep the two Metre Social Distancing requirement when receiving Holy Communion. Ballyfarnon and Arigna will continue to have all Masses, Via Facebook and local radio until further notice.

Important Notice: everyone who enters Kilronan Parish Churches or church grounds must take personal responsibility for their own safety.

The Priest and the minister of the Eucharist who will be distributing Holy Communion are required to wear a Face Mask. All are reminded that Holy Communion must on the Hand. Also Please note, for the present, it is not advisable to have altar servers or choirs for Masses.

As Churches re-open it is most important that people who are vulnerable or unwell and especially those with any symptoms that might suggest Covid-19 infection, should stay at home.

The dispensation from Sunday and Holy Day Obligation is extended.

Marriage ceremonies may take place, observing social distancing and any other public health guidelines and only if the Registrar has issued the required documentation. A new Marriage Registration Form is required when there is a change of date. The following conditions apply: The number present is determined by the social distancing measure of 2 metres. In larger churches with capacity, the total figure present should not exceed 50, including celebrant, sacristan and volunteers. Hand sanitiser should be available; Social distancing should be maintained; The protocols for Mass should be followed; The area of the church used for the wedding must be cleaned / sanitised before and after the ceremony.

First Holy Communion: Each parish may decide on the most suitable date for First Communion.

Individual Baptisms may be celebrated, under the following conditions: The number present is determined by the social distancing measure of 2 metres. In larger churches with capacity the total figure present should not exceed 50. including the celebrant, and volunteers.

Funerals: The number present is determined by the social distancing measure of 2 metres. In larger churches with capacity, the total figure present should not exceed 50, including celebrant, and volunteers.
