Mass Times for this week on Facebook and Local Radio. Vigil Mass Saturday evening in Ballyfarnon at 7p.m Arigna, Sunday, 10a.m. Keadue, Sunday, 11.30a.m. Weekday Masses @ 10a.m.; Monday in Keadue; Tuesday & Wednesday in Arigna; Thursday and Friday in Ballyfarnon.

During the Month of November we remember all the faithful departed, Monday 2nd of November is **All Souls Day**; When we commemorate all the Faithful Departed. Mass will be celebrated via Facebook and on Local Radio in Keadue Church. In preparation for the November Masses you are invited to drop in a list of those whom you wish to be remembered in the November Masses. There is a special Box in each of the Churches for November Lists.

Every week during the month of November three Masses will be offered each week. Mondays, Keadue, Wednesdays Arigna and Ballyfarnon Thursdays for your deceased relatives and friends and for all who are remembered in the November lists of the dead.

A special Mass in memory of all who died from the parish since the 15th November 2019 will be celebrated at a later date, on line. Details will appear on next weeks newsletter.

Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of all souls. From 12 o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November to 8 November. 2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence once per day - applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions. Have Confessed receive Holy Communion and Prayed for the Popes intentions.
