




Second Sunday in Ordinary Time year B.

St Ronan's Hall is situated in Keadue and provides a venue for functions and many other groups and is home to Keadue Social Services.

The Hall was built in 1940 and now needs major refurbishment.

Because of the major cost, with the Architect's advice work has to be undertaken in phases.

To date a grant was received from Roscommon Leader Partnership to replace and insulate the roof, update the toilets and sewerage system.

A grant from Roscommon County Council to replace windows and doors and to upgrade the forecourt of the hall.

Match grant funding has to be raised by Hall Committee. Due to the present Covid situation fundraising has been interrupted and the hall has not generated any income. A draw was considered to be our best option, the success of which depends on your support.
