The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.



Today's gospel is full of contradictory responses. First, the people who heard him were "astonished." Then, "they took offense at him." Jesus himself came to "his native place," probably expecting to feel at home but instead he felt rejected and unwanted: "He was amazed at their lack of faith." The people from Nazareth saw only "the carpenter, the son of Mary," and their lack of faith hindered Jesus' power. We keep thinking of others as we knew them several years ago, when perhaps they were simply "one of us." Our attitude can hinder the growth of our faith life that enables us to see and love others as God sees and loves them.
