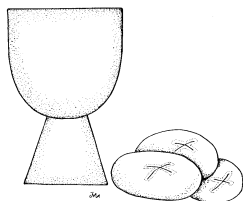

When giving the cup he claims, "This is my blood of the covenant," adding, "which will be shed for many
