## The Fourteenth Sunday of the Year



'God save all here' is a traditional Irish blessing, spoken on entering someone's home or arriving at a gathering. It was also used as a general greeting when entering a public house, and is often heard in films depicting life in early 20th century Ireland. Other variations traditionally spoken on crossing a threshold include 'God bless all here' or 'God bless all in this house'. When you called to a house where people were at work you greeted them by saying 'God bless the work'. While not in use as much these days, such greetings serve to set the tone for a visit. They indicate that the visitor has come in peace, with good wishes for all present— he or she bears no ill will to anyone.

Today Jesus recommends a specific greeting for his disciples to use when entering a home: 'Peace to this house!' Whatever house the disciples go into, this should be their greeting. Like the traditional Irish blessings, these words set a tone. Jesus explains that if a person of peace lives in that house, 'your peace will go and rest on him'. The peace blessing offered by the disciples will spread to those they meet. Peace should be our number one consideration in our dealings with others. (Triona Doherty - Intercom)

**A Reminder** of the policy drawn up by the Parish Pastoral Council some time ago. **Funeral Masses, Months Minds Masses and First Anniversary Masses** have priority over all booked Anniversary Masses. Months Minds Mass should be booked around the time of the Funeral Mass to allow sufficient time to rearrange any already booked anniversary Masses. The First Anniversary Mass should be booked at the time of the Funeral or at the time of the Months Mind so as to avoid as much as possible any inconvenience to families who have already booked an anniversary Mass. Due to the increasing number of families seeking anniversary Masses for their loved ones multiple anniversary Masses will be celebrated in all three Churches. Anyone who doesn't wish to share a Mass with other families should book one of the weekday Masses.
