The Eleventh Sunday of the Year

Why did the Pharisee invite Jesus to dine with him? Did he want to learn about the forgiveness available to even the greatest sinner? Or did he, perhaps, just want to show our trie latest lad containing town for the amusement of his friends? Today's reading indicates the invitation was a pretense for the host to entertain by Or did he, perhaps, just want to show off the latest "fad" celebrity in the latter—the invitation was a pretense for the host to entertain by ridiculing Jesus. The Pharisee's rudeness defied even the most

ordinary courtesies of foot cleansing and cultural greeting. But the Lord accepted his invitation and turned the tables of inhospitality into eternal lessons.

The snickers of the host presumed the woman who begged forgiveness for her failings was intrinsically sinful. He failed to separate the sin from the sinner. He did not perceive that forgiveness was available for the asking. Jesus words, "the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little," imply the host was guilty of sin, and that his failure to recognize the sin and repent froze his ability to love and to be forgiven.
