Thirtieth Sunday of Ordinary Time



This parable of the Pharisee and the sinner is familiar to us all. The tax collector's prayer is heartfelt. He believes sincerely that he is an unworthy sinner. He stays back from the "place" of the Pharisee and quietly asks for mercy. He is acknowledging that everything good comes from God, that God has the power and even the desire to shower mercy and grace on those who sin and repent sincerely. Without that sincerity of heart, even those who might be giving quietly

to the poor and fasting and tithing and doing all sorts of good works may not be humble. Giving alms and fasting can be mechanical gestures. Letting go of one's ego and fully accepting one's frailties is the point of the tax collector's humbling experience. Doing good works out of love for God and God's love for us is the first step in reaching for true humility of heart.

Indulgences: 1. From 12 o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2 November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November to 8 November.

2. The faithful who Visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1 to 8 November. The conditions mentioned in 1 above apply also for this.

November Lists for the faithful departed are available in the three churches. List can be left in the boxes provided or on the Altar.
